COUNTY COUNCIL OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY MARYLAND

CB-003-2024 (DR-2) - AN ACT CONCERNING MANDATORY LACTATION ROOMS IN COUNTY BUILDINGS for the purpose of requiring lactation rooms in certain County buildings and or real property.

ENACTED: 6/4/2024; SIGNED: 6/24/2024; EFFECTIVE: 8/9/2024

CB-004-2024 (DR-2) – AN ACT CONCERNING PARENTAL LEAVE ELIGIBILITY for the purpose of revising the amount of parental leave time granted to County employees.

ENACTED: 6/4/2024; SIGNED: 6/24/2024; EFFECTIVE: 8/9/2024

CB-008-2024 - AN ACT CONCERNING TEMPORARY RENT STABILIZATION ACT OF 2023 for the purpose of extending the sunset date of the Temporary Rent Stabilization Act of 2023 for a period of six (6) months from April 17, 2024 to October 17, 2024 to continue combating the existing public emergency affecting the public health, safety, and welfare; said emergency being the threat of homelessness due to a lack of affordable housing.

CB-009-2024 - AN ACT CONCERNING EMERGENCY 9-1-1 VOLUNTARY REGISTRY for the purpose of establishing the voluntary registry for emergency 9-1-1 calls, known as the Emergency 9-1-1 Voluntary Call Registry, to alert certain first responders of certain behaviors, diagnoses, or traits of individuals with special needs that may be present during certain encounters with first responders.

CB-012-2024 - AN ACT CONCERNING PROCUREMENT PRACTICES REVISIONS for the purpose of amending provisions of Subtitle 10A regarding administrative procedures, award of contracts, and economic development; generally relating to procurements subject to Subtitle 10A.

ENACTED: 6/4/2024; SIGNED: 6/24/2024; EFFECTIVE: 8/9/2024

CB-013-2024 (DR 2) – AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING CANNABIS USES for the purpose of adding definitions and designating areas for Cannabis uses consistent with authority set forth in State law; prohibiting On-site cannabis consumption uses; setting forth regulations for permitted Cannabis uses; providing for the prospective application of provisions and amendments adopted herein; and providing a severability clause for the provisions related to Cannabis uses in Prince George's County.

ENACTED: 4/9/2024; EFFECTIVE: 5/28/2024

CB-017-2024 –AN ACT CONCERNING THE BOARD OF APPEALS COMPOSITION AND SALARY REVISION for the purpose of decreasing the composition of the Board of Appeals, increasing the monthly salary rate for each member of the Board of Appeals and the additional annual salary rate for the Chairman of the Board of Appeals.

CB-020-2024 (DR-3) –AN ACT CONCERNING CONCERNING WOODLAND AND WILDLIFE CONSERVATION ORDINANCE

for the purpose of revising the existing subtitle in order to comply with state mandated revisions as per the Maryland Forest Conservation Act; revising and adding definitions; revising applicability and exemption requirements; revising plan review, validity and grandfathering requirements; revising a certain definition; providing for a certain fee-in-lieu; establishing a certain Fund; revising the variance and appeal process; revising enforcement process; revising the conservation requirements including priority areas, thresholds and replacement ratios; revising conservation requirements design criteria, priorities, options and bonding; revising forest stand delineation area; and revising forest harvesting.

CB-021-2024 (DR-2) – AN ACT CONCERNING TREE CANOPY COVERAGE ORDINANCE

for the purpose of revising the existing applicability language, requiring a certain grandfather provision, revising the tree canopy coverage requirements, revising the credit and security requirements, and adding the Planning Director to those that can issue waivers.

CB-022-2024 (DR-2) -AN ACT CONCERNING SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS’ ENVIRONMENTAL STRATEGY AREA

for the purpose of removing environmental strategy area from definitions, and removing environmental strategy area from environmental standard and replacing with development location, and amending the required minimum stream buffer widths.

CB-024-2024 (DR-2) – AN ACT CONCERNING PROCUREMENT REVISIONS

for the purpose of replacing references to the Office of Central Services Director with the Purchasing Agent and references to Office of Central Services with the Office of Procurement.

ENACTED: 6/4/2024; SIGNED: 6/24/2024; EFFECTIVE: 8/9/2024

CB-028-2024 (DR-2) – AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING NONRESIDENTIAL BASE ZONES—PERMITTED PRINCIPAL USES—CIGAR CLUB/LOUNGE

for the purpose of defining the use, “Cigar Club/Lounge,” in the Zoning Ordinance; permitting the use in the CN (Commercial, Neighborhood), CS (Commercial, Service), and CGO (Commercial, General, and Office) zones of the County; and establishing regulations governing the use in furtherance of the public safety, health, and welfare of the residents of Prince George’s County.

ENACTED: 6/4/2024; EFFECTIVE: 7/22/2024

CB-029-2024 (DR-3) – AN ACT CONCERNING JUVENILE AND MINOR CURFEW ZONES

for the purpose of allowing commercial property owners the ability to request the Police Chief to create zones within the County with a more restrictive juvenile or minor curfew; providing for the application for a more restrictive juvenile or minor curfew zone including the specification of the area covered following reasonable geographical boundaries; providing that the proposed area is primarily commercial; providing that the applicant demonstrates the ability to provide notice to the public of the more restrictive juvenile or minor curfew zone; and providing the applicant includes a

letter of support from at least one County Council member that represents the district containing the more restrictive juvenile or minor curfew zone.

CB-037-2024 (DR-2) – AN ACT CONCERNING SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATIONS for the purpose of declaring additional revenue and appropriating to the General Fund and Internal Service Fund to provide for costs that were not anticipated and included in the Approved Fiscal Year 2024 Budget.

ENACTED: 6/4/2024; SIGNED: 6/24/2024 ; EFFECTIVE: 8/9/2024

CB-044-2024 – AN ACT CONCERNING MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING COMMISSION for the purpose of approving the Prince George’s County portion of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission budget and making appropriations and levying certain taxes for Fiscal Year 2025 for the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, pursuant to the provisions of the Land Use Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended (“Land Use Article”).

ENACTED: 5/23/2024; SIGNED: 5/30/2024; EFFECTIVE: 7/1/2024

CB-045-2024 – AN ACT CONCERNING FISCAL YEAR 2025 APPROPRIATIONS for the purpose of making appropriations for the support of the County government and for the Prince George’s Community College and for the schools, institutions, departments, offices, boards, commissions, and agencies of Prince George’s County, and for other purposes, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025; adopting the current expense budget, the capital improvement program, and the capital budget prepared according to the Charter of Prince George’s County and submitted by the County Executive to the County Council; appropriating the items of expense in said current expense budget; establishing rates of reimbursement for subsistence expenses for employees of the County; providing for the inclusion of all State, Federal and private grants received subsequent to adoption of the current expense budget; imposing the applicable income and special tax rates under the public general laws and public local laws of Maryland; all to be known as the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance of Prince George’s County for Fiscal Year 2025.
