| Clinton Baptist Church | \$5,000 | Clinton Baptist Church will use grant funds to continue feeding the Homeless, providing care packages that include masks, gloves, hand sanitizers, etc. provide food packages and groceries through the church's Pantry. |
| Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men | \$3,000 | Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men will use grant funds to support two of their major programs in providing annual scholarships to Prince George's County High school seniors and to provide food & monetary donations to families in need of assistance that live in the County. |
| E.V.O.L.V.E., Inc. | \$2,500 | E.V.O.L.V.E., Inc. will use grant funds to implement programs that provide stress management, mental health forums for high school students navigating uncertainty during pandemic; procure stress relief tools, journals, and related materials incorporated in healthcare of students. |
| Food & Friends, Inc. | \$5,000 | Food & Friends will use grant funds to provide medically-tailored, home-delivered meals and groceries to individuals with serious illnesses such as HIV/AIDS and cancer that are too ill to buy or prepare food for themselves. |
| Hope Connections for Cancer Support, Inc. | \$1,000 | Hope Connections for Cancer Support, Inc. will use grant funds to help people with cancer and their loved ones deal with the social, emotional, and physical impact of cancer through professionally facilitated programs of emotional support, education, wellness, and hope. |
| Ivy Community Charities of Prince George's County, Inc. | \$2,500 | The Ivy Community Charities of Prince George's County, Inc. will use grant funds to provide scholarships to students who reside in or attend a school in District 9. |
| Jacob's Ladder, Inc. | \$1,000 | Jacob's Ladder will use requested grant funds to support their ongoing programs: Diversion, Reentry, COVID Relief, Junior Workforce Academy and Media Relations Division which aim to reduce the number of juveniles entering and returning to the juvenile justice system. |
| NAMI Prince George's County, Inc. | \$5,000 | NAMI Prince George's County will use grant funds for expenses related to providing mental health support, education, advocacy and community outreach for county residents. |
