Clinton Baptist Church	\$5,000	Clinton Baptist Church will use grant funds to continue feeding the Homeless, providing care packages that include masks, gloves, hand sanitizers, etc. provide food packages and groceries through the church's Pantry.
Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men	\$3,000	Coalition of Concerned Black Christian Men will use grant funds to support two of their major programs in providing annual scholarships to Prince George's County High school seniors and to provide food & monetary donations to families in need of assistance that live in the County.
