E.V.O.L.V.E., Inc.	\$2,500	E.V.O.L.V.E., Inc. will use grant funds to implement programs that provide stress management, mental health forums for high school students navigating uncertainty during pandemic; procure stress relief tools, journals, and related materials incorporated in healthcare of students.
Food & Friends, Inc.	\$5,000	Food & Friends will use grant funds to provide medically-tailored, home-delivered meals and groceries to individuals with serious illnesses such as HIV/AIDS and cancer that are too ill to buy or prepare food for themselves.
Hope Connections for Cancer Support, Inc.	\$1,000	Hope Connections for Cancer Support, Inc. will use grant funds to help people with cancer and their loved ones deal with the social, emotional, and physical impact of cancer through professionally facilitated programs of emotional support, education, wellness, and hope.
