Organization Name	Amount	Grant Purpose
Mission of Love Charities, Incorporated	\$20,000	Mission of Love Charities will use grant funds to support low-income and homeless individuals and families in Prince George's County. Services will include provision of food, job training, furniture, clothing, mental health referrals and a day center.
Food & Friends, Inc.	\$20,000	Food & Friends will use grant funds to provide medically-tailored meals and groceries to people living with serious illnesses like HIV, cancer, diabetes, COPD, end stage renal disease, etc. whose illness prevents them from shopping for and preparing food themselves.
United Communities Against Poverty, Inc. aka A Shepherd's Cove	\$20,000	United Communities Against Poverty, Inc. aka A Shepherd's Cove will use grant funds to support Shepherd's Cove general support for residents residing in the shelter.
Prince George's Child Resource Center, Inc.	\$30,000	Prince George's Child Resource Center will use grant funds for general operating expenses to sustain Family Connects Prince George's, a nursing home visiting program in the stadium impact area. More specifically, grant funds will support its nurses' compensation.
Glenarden American Legion Auxiliary Post 275	\$10,000	To provide support to veterans, active duty military, their families, children and youth, and the community through our outreach programs.
